Design & create unique jewelry pieces including pendant earrings & necklaces, bracelets, beads, barrettes & rings. Using porcelain for its smoothness & durability, pieces will be finished with glaze & glass. *All metal components will be provided.*

## **WEEK 6: July 17 - 21 | Freaky Tiki**

Take a trip to the Polynesian islands & hand-build & carve a towering tiki statue, an Easter Island head, a silly swinging monkey, indoor/outdoor tabletop tiki torches & of course a one-of-a-kind tropical tiki tumbler.

## **WEEK 7: July 24 - 28 | Fabulous Fungi**

Back by popular demand – because we are obsessed with all things mushroomy! Looking at healing & sometimes deadly characteristics, identify some of the 10,000 varieties & create single & cluster mushrooms including morels, oysters, inky caps, toadstools, turkey tails & more.
